PASHA HAS BEEN WORKING FOR MANY YEARS IN SCULPTING, WRITING AND TRANSLATION

SINCE HE HELD HIS FIRST EXHIBITION IN SYRIA IN THE MID-SIXTIES, HE HAS BEEN INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP EXHIBITIONS AROUND THE WORLD, FROM CUBA TO SOUTH KOREA. 1969 WON THE FIRST PRIZE FOR PHOTOGRAPHY IN THE YOUNG ARTISTS CONTEST. LATER, HE TRANSFERRED TO THE FACULTY OF FINE ARTS, AND WAS GRANTED A SCHOLARSHIP FROM THE HIGH EDUCATION MINISTRY TO STUDY SCULPTURE IN MOSCOW, RUSSIA

1977-1970IN MOSCOW, HE FINISHED HIS STUDIES IN MONUMENTAL SCULPTURE AND WAS OFFERED TEACHING ASSISTANT JOB IN THE SURIKOV ART INSTITUTE, MOSCOW

1977RETURNED TO SYRIA, HOWEVER, THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION ASSIGNED HIM AS A .TEACHER IN UNRWA SCHOOLS IN AL-HASAKAH

1978 JOINED THE ARMY AFTER THE GOVERNMENT REFUSED TO ASSIGN HIM AS A TEACHER 1981 STARTED A PH.D. IN ARCHEOLOGY AND ART HISTORY IN THE SORBONNE UNIVERSITY, PARIS, BUT DID NOT FINISH

1983-1982 MOVED TO SPAIN, THEN RETURNED BACK TO SYRIA

1987 MOVED TO SPAIN, WHERE HE CURRENTLY LIVES
